I. Purpose:

To prevent class, laboratory, library, and campus disruptions created by non-instructional electronic or other devices.

II. Definitions: N/A

III. Policy:

The use of all electronic sound devices, with or without earphones, such as pagers, cellular telephones, electronic games, portable televisions, radios/tape players, etc., is prohibited in classrooms, laboratories, open computer laboratories, Testing Centers, Academic Support Centers, Access Centers, and libraries. Electronic devices generating disruptive sounds on campus, such as boom boxes, auto sound systems, musical instruments, etc., are also prohibited.

Students may be permitted to bring non-sound electronic pagers to class.

Students with documented disabilities may use approved electronic devices as specified by the Accommodations Notification Form, JSRCC Form #75-0006, completed by the Office of Student Accommodations.

Electronic devices approved by the instructor to be used in the learning process are exempted from this policy.

IV. Procedures:

If disciplinary action is necessary, the disciplinary procedures outlined in [JSRCC Policy 1-35, Student Conduct](#), Section IV, will be followed.
