## Get a Jump on Your College Education and Career

If your high school participates in Dual Enrollment, you can get a head start on your college and career plans. You take college level courses at one of the JSRCC campuses or at your high school/technical center. Dual Enrollment courses fulfill both your high school and college graduation requirements. The program is designed to facilitate a seamless transition for you from high school to college. If you are eligible, you can choose transfer or technical education courses.

### Benefits of Dual Enrollment

- You can complete up to one year of college prior to graduating from high school.
- You can earn both high school and college credits.
- You get first-hand exposure to the requirements of college-level work in a supportive environment.
- You gain skills that will ease the transition into the workforce.

## How Do I Enroll?

The Reynolds Dual Enrollment team will work closely with you in partnership with your high school personnel. First meet with your high school counselor to determine which courses are right for you then call us at 804.523.5789.

- Placement Test as needed for Course Enrollment
