Credits: 1

Course Title: Individualized Instruction in Writing

Course Description (including lecture hours, lab hours, total contacts)

Focuses on individual writing needs as determined by student and instructor. Provides support for students simultaneously enrolled in other courses or who want additional writing instruction in a tutorial setting. Corequisite: ENG 111. Lecture 1 hour per week.

General Course Purpose

ENG 9 gives students the opportunity to receive individualized conferences in order to succeed in a co-enrolled ENG 111 course.
