1. **COURSE PREFIX and NUMBER:** FRE 201 **CREDIT HOURS:** 3
2. **COURSE TITLE:** Intermediate French I
3. **PREREQUISITES:** French 102 or equivalent
4. **COURSE DESCRIPTION:** Continues to develop understanding, speaking, reading, and writing skills. French is used in the classroom.
5. **CONTENT:** (Major Headings)
 - a. Structures: Past tenses, including compound tenses and past participles and Future Tense;
 - b. Pronouns (direct and indirect, reflexive and stressed).
 - c. Vocabulary building through the use of all four skills.
 - d. Francophone culture, including economic, historical, geographical, and cultural information.

6. **GENERAL COURSE OBJECTIVES:**

Upon successful completion of the course, the student will be able to:

- a. Comprehend and use at least the most common 800 vocabulary words in French
- b. Acquire further useable vocabulary through new words, concepts, and verb forms.
- c. Apply practically the grammar and verbs learned in French 101-102.
- d. Write simple compositions and participate in classroom discussions by utilizing the skills mentioned in a, b, and c.
- e. Gain an appreciation of Francophone culture and its influence in today's world.
- f. Function at Low- to Mid-Intermediate level of the ACTFL Rating Scale.
