1. COURSE PREFIX and NUMBER: **HLT 220** CREDIT HOURS: 3

2. COURSE TITLE: **Concepts of Disease**

3. PREREQUISITES: None

4. COURSE DESCRIPTION: Emphasizes general principles, classifications, causes, and treatments of selected disease processes. Intended primarily for students enrolled in health technology programs. Lecture 3 hours per week.
