**Course Title:** Advanced Class Piano II

Teaches advanced applications of keyboard fundamentals and technical skills. Includes exercises in intervals, triads, all major and minor scales, and simple and compound meters. Uses advanced repertoire. Lecture 1 hour. Laboratory 2 hours. Total 3 hours per week.

**General Course Purpose:**

Required for the AAA degree in Music. This course provides enhancement in keyboard technique, performance, and interpretation on the foundation built in MUS 141, 142, and 241.

- a. Play all scales, hands together
- b. Play all diatonic triads in keys
