### **COURSE OUTLINE**

**COURSE PREFIX and NUMBER:** SPA 102

**CREDIT HOURS:** 4

**COURSE TITLE:** Beginning Spanish II

**PREREQUISITES:** Spanish 101 or its equivalent

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** Introduces understanding, speaking, reading, and writing skills and emphasizes basic Spanish sentence structure. Incorporates exposure to the arts, culture, and literature of the areas of the world where Spanish is spoken. May include an additional hour of oral drill and practice per week. Lecture 4 hours per week.

#### **MAJOR TOPICS TO BE COVERED:**

- A. Pronunciation
- B. Basic Dialogues
- C. Essential Vocabulary used in basic conversations
- D. Travel in Spain, Mexico, and Latin America
- E. Current events and culture in Spanish speaking countries
- F. Grammar: regular and irregular verbs of present, preterit and imperfect tenses

**GENERAL COURSE OBJECTIVES:** Upon successful completion of the course, the student will be able to:

- A. Demonstrate understanding of concepts of Spanish pronunciation and sound system
- B. Demonstrate knowledge of basic vocabulary, including idiomatic phrases
- C. Demonstrate appropriate use of gender, subject, and verb agreement
- D. Use regular and irregular verbs in the present tense indicative
- E. Correctly form and use declarative and interrogative sentences
- F. Demonstrate listening comprehension and speaking skills at the beginner's level; novice to mid-novice
- G. Identify and discuss some elements of Spanish customs and culture
