1. COURSE PREFIX and NUMBER: **SPA 195** **CREDIT HOURS: 3**
2. COURSE TITLE: **Spanish for Health Professionals**
3. PREREQUISITES: None
4. COURSE DESCRIPTION: Introduces Spanish to those in the health sciences. Emphasizes oral communication and practical medical vocabulary. May include oral drill and practice. Lecture 3 hours per week.

 - c. Essential vocabulary used in basic conversation.
 - d. Grammar: nouns, adjectives, regular and irregular verbs-present tense
