

## LPN General Information

### **Requirements for all applicants into the LPN Program include the following:**

- Completion of all JSRCC developmental course work prescribed as a result of JSRCC placement tests in reading, writing, and math ([ENG 04](#), [ENG 107](#), [ENG 01](#), [MTH 02](#)).
- Completion of as many of the non-nursing courses listed in the curriculum below as possible to help prepare for the LPN program.
- Potential LPN students planning to enroll in the RN Program are strongly encouraged to take [NAS 161-162](#) instead of NAS 150. NAS 161 has prerequisites of high school biology and chemistry

### **Computer Competency Requirement:**

- Pass either the computer competency exam, administered in the testing centers at each campus, or successfully complete [ITE 115](#) or [CSC 155](#) prior to entering [PNE 141](#).

**CPR Requirement:** All applicants to the Practical Nursing Program must obtain the American Heart Association's *Basic Life Support for Health Care Providers* certification prior to entering PNE 141.
