**ALL STUDENTS SEEKING ENTRY INTO THE AAS NURSING PROGRAM
MUST COMPLETE TWO STEPS:**

- 1. Complete Pre-Nursing and Allied Health CSC requirements

- 2. After completion of Pre-Nursing and Allied Health CSC, Apply to
AAS Nursing Program (See *AAS NURSING PROGRAM PACKET* for

You will not be allowed to add a new course or switch to another course after this period. • Note: Eight week terms have earlier deadlines than 16 week semesters.
<p>If you must withdraw from a course, you must</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do so prior to the withdrawal deadline (approximately mid-semester).
